Application details the number of students who will be impacted on an annual basis and that students will be impacted over multiple years.	20
<b>Community Impact</b>	Application shows how the project will positively impact the local/regional agricultural industry and/or the community.	20
<b>Partnerships</b>	Application shows partnerships between agricultural education program and educational agencies, local agricultural groups, and/or industry partners	15
<b>Letters of Support</b>	Letters of support demonstrate that outside partners are committed to the project and will help make it a success.	5
