

Middle School Essay Contest

Event Rules

All members participating in this event must meet the eligibility requirements and adhere to the rules of the Kentucky FFA Association as outlined in the Kentucky FFA Middle School General Rules.

Each chapter is eligible to submit three essays.

Essays must be submitted to the Executive Secretary by May 1st.

Event Procedures

Essay cannot exceed five hundred (500) words.

The essay must address the State FFA Theme for the current year. The theme is released during National FFA Week.

The essay must be typed. No pictures are allowed in the essay.

All essays will be compared regardless of age or grade of the author.

Scoring

Essays will be scored on the following basis:

Proper grammar and punctuation	15 points
How well does author address the theme	35 points
Organization and clarity	25 points
Originality	15 points
Essay relates to the agricultural industry	10 points
