This event will consist of two components as outlined below.

SEED IDENTIFICATION (200 POINTS)

Participants will identify 40 different seeds.

The list of possible seeds is posted on www.kyffa.org.

All answers for this component will be placed on the scantron form provided to each participant. An example is provided.

SEED TAG CLASSES (200 POINTS)

Participants will judge four classes of seed tags. For each class they will place four seed tags based on the information located on the tags. The four classes of seed tags will be:

- Red Clover
- Kentucky 31 Fescue
- Wheat
- Orchard Grass

All answers for this component will be placed on the scantron form provided to each participant. An example is provided.

Scoring

Possible score for each participant is 400 points.

Individuals will be ranked in numerical order on the basis of the final individual score.

TIEBREAKER
