Land Judging and Homesite Evaluation Guidelines

Event Rules

All members participating in this Career Development Event must meet the eligibility requirements and adhere to the rules of the Kentucky FFA Association as outlined in the Rules Governing FFA Activities document.

Number of members on a team: Four (the top three individual scores count toward the team score)

Official Dress Appropriate: No

Regional Event: Determined by the region

State Event: November

"4-H Land Judging in Kentucky" is the official reference for this event and may be obtained through the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service.

The Land Judging Career Development Event and Homesite Career Development Event will be held on the same date and use the same sites.

Each chapter may send one team of four members. Members will have the opportunity to compete in one or both events but will use their eligibility for both events.

Participants will judge four sites, using the official score card.

Each region is eligible to send the top two teams in Land Judging and the top two teams in Homesite Evaluation.

The top five teams in the state in Land Judging and the top five teams in Homesite Evaluation are eligible to represent Kentucky at the National Land and Range Judging Contest which is held in Oklahoma in May.

Scoring

Possible score for each participant in Land Judging is 412 points, with a possible team score of 1,236 points. Possible score for each participant in Homesite Evaluation is 400 points, with a possible team score of 1200 points.

The top three team members' scores will count toward the team score.

Teams will be ranked in numerical order on the basis of the final team score.

Individuals will be ranked in numerical order on the basis of the final individual score.

TIEBREAKER

Ties will be broken by the fourth team member's score. In chapters where only three members judged; the chapter having four members will be selected the winner.
