



Commodity Gifting

Instructions for Grain Elevators and Stockyards

The Kentucky FFA Foundation is now accepting commodities as donations. These gifts support FFA members in need as well as local chapters. If you conduct business with a farmer that would be interested in making a donation, the process is simple!

1. Create an account for the Kentucky FFA Foundation, Inc. The farmer will donate an allotted amount of grain to this account prior to sale.

2. Any donations need to be sold and settled at the end of each day or at the time the donation is made, whichever is best for your accounting purposes. The Foundation does not assume any risk of tracking any grain, incurring storage charges, risk of loss or transportation costs. If there are any loan deficiency payments available, make sure those are taken before transferring the grain.
3. Donations can be made anonymously or name of the donor may be placed on the memo line of the check. We would like to thank any donors, but we understand some wish to remain anonymous.
4. Please send checks to the Kentucky FFA Foundation at the above address. The producer will receive a letter from the Kentucky FFA Foundation acknowledging the gift.
