

**Kentucky Association of Agricultural Educators
Johnnie Mathias Scholarship**

Guidelines

1. In order for a student to be eligible to apply for a Kentucky Association of Agricultural Educators (KAAE) Scholarship, all teachers of agriculture in his/her school must be KAAE members.
2. Applicants must be graduating seniors and dues paying FFA members.
3. Applicants must be enrolling in an accredited two or four year institution or career and technical institution and majoring in some area of agriculture.

Submit the following to the FFA Executive Secretary by April 1

1. Completed application form
2. High School Transcript
3. Three letters of recommendation (one should be from a teacher of agriculture)
4. FFA activity sheet
5. Essay- In 500 words or less, explain why you desire a career in agriculture and why you feel you deserve the KAAE Scholarship.
