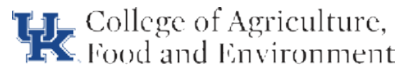

HOW TO USE ONECAUSE MOBILE BIDDING

Use your smartphone to start bidding on items now.

HOW DO I FIND ITEMS?

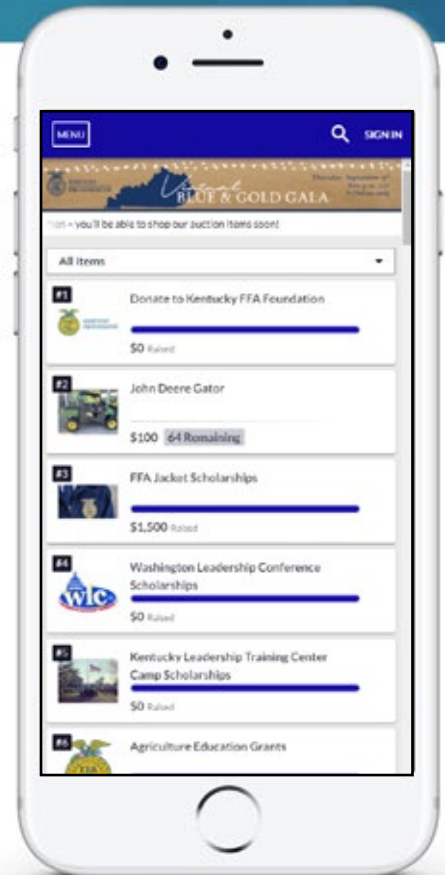

buys an FFA jacket.

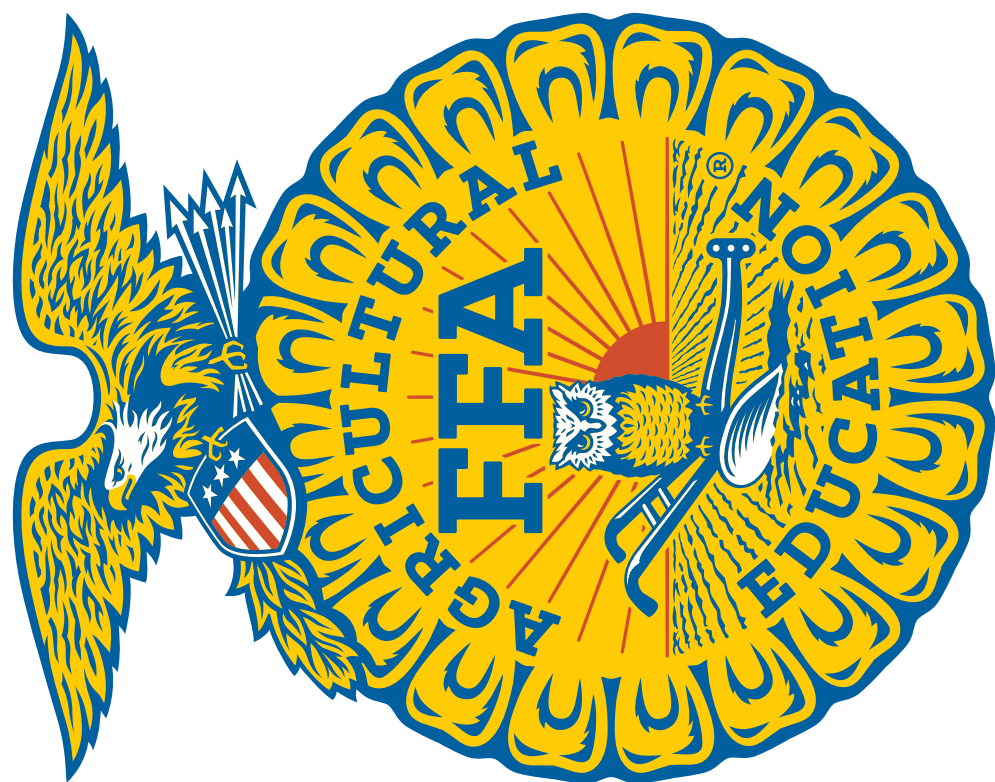
