Entries- Make the following entries for the year 2024

- On September 15, you bought two feeder pigs from Montgomery Acres Farm. You paid \$50 each and identified them as #1 and #2.
- On September 18, you bought hog feed from Sunshine Mills for \$40.
- On September 30, you were paid \$11 per hour for 28 hours of work at Uncle Andy's Pumpkin Patch. \$48 was deducted for taxes.
- On October 14, you purchased a hog feeder from Rural King for \$350. You believe it has a useful life of 10 years and a salvage value of \$25.
- On October 25-28 you attended the National FFA Convention and Expo. You record 40 hours including travel.
- On October 31, you were paid \$11 per hour for 38 hours of work at Uncle Andy's Pumpkin Patch. \$67 was deducted for taxes.
- On November 24, you volunteered 6 hours with the local Day of Hope Event.
- On November 30, you participated in the regional Welding CDE. Your team placed 2nd. You record 5 hours for travel and competition.
- On December 22, you worked 4 hours for your father (outside your SAE) to pay for your space in the barn for your hogs. You value this work at \$48.

Entries- Make the following entries for the year 2025

- On January 3, you sold pig #1 to Luke Williams for \$450.
- On January 15, you took out an FSA Youth Loan (capital loan) to begin a mowing business. You borrowed \$4800 at 6% interest and will make 1 payment per year for 4 years.
- On January 16, you sold pig #2 to Parker Jones for \$475.
- On January 28, you bought a Cub Cadet ZT1 mower from Tractor Supply Company for \$4500. You believe the mower has a useful life of 10 years and a salvage value of \$800.
- On February 6, your grandmother gave you a 6 foot trailer. You estimate the value at \$400. It has a 10 year life and a salvage value of \$150.
- On March 10, you bought a Stihl Trimmer for \$230 from Page Supply Company. You believe it has a 5 year life and a salvage value of \$50.
- On March 13, you win the regional Prepared Public Speaking Contest. You journal 5 hours for competition and travel.
- On April 1, you purchase mower gas and oil from Rudy's Quick Stop for \$26.

- On May 1, you paid Ben Wilson \$50 for helping you mow lawns in the month of April.
- On May 6, you bought two baby pigs from Montgomery Acres Farm. You identify them as #3 and #4 and pay \$20 each for the pigs.
- On May 8, you purchase hog feed and bedding from Keyes Supply Company for \$46.
- On June 12-16 you attended the Kentucky FFA Leadership Training Center. You record 35 hours.
- On June 30, you were paid \$450 for mowing the Mt. Pisgah Church Cemetery for the first half of the year.
- On July 4, you volunteered with the Cattleman's Group to cook steaks at the 4th of July Celebration. You worked 6 hours.
- On July 15, you mowed your Uncle Ben's yard in exchange for bedding for your pigs. You value the mowing at \$75. Journal as Plant Systems and PS.01.01.
- On July 28, you bought new mower blades, spark plugs, and an air filter from Long's Automotive. The total cost was \$84.
- On August 2, you bought veterinary supplies and supplements for your hogs from Green Hill Veterinary Clinic for \$45.
- On August 15, you were paid \$40 for mowing Aunt Sally's lawn.
- On August 18, you bought a new 8 foot mower trailer from Lee Trailer Sales for \$850. You believe it has a salvage value of \$200 and a useful life of 20 years.
- On September 10, you sold your old 6 foot mower trailer to Noah Wilson for \$400.
- On October 20, you participated in the Regional Land Judging Contest. You count 4 hours.
- On October 25, you were paid \$250 for mowing by your Uncle George.
- On October 30, you were paid \$600 for mowing and leaf removal at the Mt. Pisgah Church Cemetery.
- On November 25, you spend \$52 on mower parts at Tractor Supply Company.
- On December 1, you made the first payment on your loan. You paid a total of \$1488- \$288 was interest and \$1200 was toward the principal.
- On December 4, you sell pig #3 to Martha Dell for \$525.
- On December 15, you withdrew \$250 to pay car insurance and buy Christmas presents.

End of Year Adjustments

- 12-31-24** Pigs #1 and #2 valued at \$450 each
Hog feed valued at \$24
- 12-31-25** 1 roll of trimmer line for your lawn care project valued at \$40
Vet supplies for pig project valued at \$32

Be sure to add the usage percentages for capital items.

End of year narratives

Placement- I worked at Uncle Andy's Pumpkin Patch where I helped drive tractors for hay rides and sell pumpkins.

Feeder Pigs

2024- I bought two feeder pigs in September. They are nearly at market weight and I hope to sell them early in the new year.

2025- I sold my pigs in January for cash. I bought two additional feeder pigs in May and sold them in December.

Lawn Care

2025- I secured an FSA Youth Loan to start my lawn care business. I bought a zero turn mower and trimmer. I began using a trailer my grandmother gave me but sold it and bought a new one.

Scope 5

At the end of the contest, you must create a PDF of the State Degree application. To do this.....

1. Go to Reports
2. Click on Application Degree Manager
3. Select "Kentucky State Degree" from the drop down menu and click "add new."
4. Click on the hyperlink "application" and complete the following steps:

On cover page enter the following:

Birth Year- 2008

Year membership began- 2024

Year Greenhand Degree received- 2024

Year Chapter Degree received- 2025

Mark that your dues are paid

Mark that you have had continuous membership

4 years of Ag are offered in your school and you have had 4 years of Ag

You did make a C or better in your Ag classes

The checklist page will show that the FFA membership number is missing. This is acceptable.

Click on "Print Application" then click on "Generate Draft PDF." You do not actually have to print the application but you are required to click on "Generate Draft PDF." **If you do not complete this step, we will have nothing to score, so this is very important!**
